NONMEDICAL MARIJUANA INTERIM URGENCY ORDINANCE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APRIL 4, 2017

Adult Use of Marijuana Act (AUMA)

- System to legalize, control, and regulate the cultivation, processing, manufacturing, distribution, testing, and sale of nonmedical cannabis
- Tax structure for the growing and retail sale of cannabis
- Provisions for the cultivation of industrial hemp
- Adults 21 years and older
- State licenses on January 1, 2018
- Compliance with local regulations



Previous Action

- Board of Supervisors on February 14th
 - Received a report on AUMA
 - Directed staff to return with an Urgency Ordinance
 - Formed ad-hoc committee
 - Directed creation of registry



Urgency Ordinance

Government Code section 65858

- Protect public safety, health, and welfare of County residents
 - Avoid the risks of criminal activity, degradation of the natural environment, minimize odors and noise pollution
- Provides the County time to analyze issues and create sound regulations

Urgency Ordinance (cont)

Temporarily Prohibits

- Cultivation, distribution, transportation,
 storage, manufacturing, and processing
- Selling of cannabis and cannabis products
- Growth of industrial hemp
- Personal outdoor cultivation

Timeline

- Effective for 45 days
- + 22 months and 15 days



Recommendation

- Adopt the Nonmedical Marijuana Interim
 Urgency Ordinance
- Determine that the Urgency Ordinance is not subject to CEQA, pursuant to sections 15061(b)(3) and 15308
- Direct staff to return with a report and an extension to the urgency ordinance on May 2, 2017
