Summary Text:

SBCEO's Conflict of Interest Code was amended February 2, 2017 and submitted to the Santa Barbara County Clerk of the Board on February 14, 2017. The amendments include new positions; and deletion of positions that have been abolished and/or positions that no longer make or participate in the making of governmental decisions. (See attached "2016 Local Agency Biennial Notice"; Amended Conflict of Interest Code; and Amended Conflict of Interest Code – redlined version).

Background:

All public agencies are required by the Political Reform Act of 1974 to:

- 1. Adopt local conflict of interest codes identifying the reporting requirements of covered employees; and,
- 2. Review the need for any revisions to their local conflict of interest codes on a biennial basis.
