# **Recommended Actions:**

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Approve and authorize the Chair to execute an Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor with **Coast Valley Worship Center DBA Coast Valley Substance Abuse Treatment Center** (a local vendor), for the provisions of substance use disorder services, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,091,340 for the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018.
- B. Determine that the above actions are government fiscal activities or funding mechanisms which do not involve any commitment to any specific project which may result in a potentially physical impact on the environment, and are therefore not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to section 15378(b)(4) of the CEQA guidelines.

### Summary Text:

The Santa Barbara County Behavioral Wellness Department provides a continuum of mental health and substance use disorder services to Santa Barbara County residents, in part through contracted providers including Community-Based Organizations (CBOs). Approval of the recommended actions will allow Behavioral Wellness to provide necessary Outpatient Drug Free, Intensive Outpatient Treatment, and

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Alcohol and Drug Free Housing Services through Coast Valley Substance Abuse Treatment Center (Coast Valley).

# **Background:**

Coast Valley provides outpatient treatment services including individual and group counseling and drug testing in Santa Maria and Lompoc. Alcohol and other Drug (AOD) treatment services are provided to Drug Medi-Cal (DMC) beneficiaries, as well as to clients referred by the Santa Barbara County Drug Court. In addition, this year Coast Valley will be providing Alcohol and Drug Free Housing in three locations for CalWorks clients, providing a safe and sober alternative as clients are actively working toward self-sufficiency.

**Contract Renewals and Performance Outcomes:** Coast Valley provides Outpatient Drug Free (ODF) treatment to youth and adults in Santa Maria and Lompoc, serving an average of 238 adults and 42 adolescents per quarter. Overall, Coast Valley has performed well, except two quarters in which the target percentage of clients with successful completion of treatment goals was not met (Q1 Adult, Lompoc and Q1 Adolescent, Lompoc and Santa Maria).

### Key Contract Risks:

As with any contract funded by State and Federal sources, there is a risk of future audit disallowances and repayments. Behavioral Wellness is required to submit an annual cost report which reports all costs associated with providing Alcohol and Drug Program services for a given Fiscal Year (actual cost). There is the risk that the State will disallow units of service or determine costs to be non-allowable, resulting in repayment. Behavioral Wellness contracts include language requiring contractors to repay any amounts disallowed in audit findings, minimizing financial risks to County.
