#### • June 2016

- BoS adopts EPRS ordinance.
- Ordinance states that EHS Director may recommend fees to the board of supervisors to recover (but not exceed) actual cost of administering and enforcing the program.

### Fee Schedule Elements



- 2 Types of Plan Review
  - Initial Plan Review
  - > 3-year Plan Update Review
- Annual Operating Expenses
  - Covers administration of the program, including: database management, website and outreach to the public, annual reports, enforcement, inspections, etc.
- Fees are Paid by the Stewardship Organization

## Comparisons

- San Francisco, Santa Clara
  Fixed fee
- Marin County
  Hourly billing




- Santa Barbara Recommendation
  - Hourly billing

- Plan Review Fees
  - > Initial Plan Review Submitted with Deposit based on number of Producers
    - 6+ Producers \$2,720 (for ~20 hours review time)
    - 1-5 Producers \$544 (for ~4 hours review time)
  - > 3-year Plan Review Submitted with Deposit based on number of Producers
    - 6+ Producers \$544 (for ~4 hours review time)
    - 1-5 Producers \$272 (for ~2 hours review time)
    - > Time spent in excess of <u>Deposit</u> billed @ \$136/hour
    - > Any remaining <u>Deposit</u> will be refunded
- Annual Operating Fee
  - > \$119 x total number of producers
  - Billed Annually
