- B. Approve and execute the California Department of Veterans Affairs Subvention and Medi-Cal Cost Avoidance Delegation of Authority letter, Fiscal Year 2017/2018.

#### **Summary Text:**

The California Department of Veterans Affairs (CalVet) requires counties participating in the funding programs offered through the State to meet certain criteria, as set forth in the County Subvention and the Medi-Cal Cost Avoidance Programs. Two documents are prerequisites to obtaining State funding for programs addressing the needs of veterans residing within Santa Barbara County.

The Subvention Certificate of Compliance specifies that the County has appointed a County Veterans Service Officer (CVSO) in accordance with the California Code of Regulations, Title 12, Subchapter 4.

The Subvention and Medi-Cal Cost Avoidance Delegation of Authority letter delegates authority to the CVSO to sign reports and forms required by CalVet for the funding of these programs.

# **Background:**

The Board's annual approval and execution of the California Department of Veterans Affairs Subvention Certificate of Compliance and the California Department of Veterans Affairs Subvention and Medi-Cal Cost Avoidance Delegation of Authority letter is necessary for participation in these funding programs.

## **Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:**

It is anticipated that the County will receive \$195,299 during the 2017/2018 fiscal year to offset costs associated with the veterans program as a result of participating in the County Subvention Program and the Medi-Cal Cost Avoidance Program.

## **Fiscal Analysis:**

The total cost of providing Veterans' Services is \$511,880 for FY 2017/2018; \$195,299 of the cost will be reimbursed through the State.
