Recommended Actions:

- a) That the Board of Supervisors, pursuant to Government Code Section 31454, adopts the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 employer and member contribution rates, recommended by Cheiron, the Santa Barbara County Employees Retirement System (SBCERS) actuary, and recommended by the Board of Retirement on December 14, 2016, with an effective date of July 1, 2017 or for the payroll cycle in which that date occurs;
- b) That the Board of Supervisors, pursuant to Government Code Section 31873, elects to pay the portion of the normal cost of living adjustment that would be otherwise assessed to individual members who are not deemed to be new members pursuant to Government Code Section 7522.04(f), with an effective date of July 1, 2017 or for the payroll cycle in which that date occurs; and
- c) That the Board of Supervisors determines that the actions above are not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(4), because they consist of government funding mechanisms or other government fiscal activities which do not involve any commitment to any specific project which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment.

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Summary Text:

The proposed action will set an overall employer contribution rate of 38.71%. This is a 2.16% contribution rate increase from the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 rate of 36.55%. The Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Recommended Operating Plan (budget) includes these expected retirement contribution rates. SBCERS reports that adjusting the rates of contribution as recommended will not reduce the individual benefits provided by either the County Employee Retirement Act of 1937 or the California Public Employees' Pension Reform Act (PEPRA) of 2013.

The Board of Retirement took action at its December 14, 2016 meeting to accept and approve the valuation and recommend the rates of contribution for approval to the Board of Supervisors.

Background:

In correspondence dated April 28, 2017, SBCERS requested that the recommended rates be brought to Board of Supervisors for adoption. The referenced correspondence is Attachment A to this item and the employer and member contribution rates resulting from the June 30, 2016 Actuarial Valuation are included in Attachment B and Attachment C, respectively.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

The Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Recommended Operating Plan (budget) includes the expected retirement cost increases, estimated to be \$7.3 million, or a 5.9% increase (from \$123.8 million to \$131.1 million).
