WHEREAS, Adolph Garza was born and raised in Lompoc, California. He graduated from Lompoc High School and joined the United States Marine Corp immediately thereafter. Adolph was in the Infantry unit and was stationed at Camp Lejune in South Carolina, and was deployed every six months, traveling to six different countries; and

WHEREAS, Adolph joined the Laborers Union when his enlistment ended in 1984. He immediately began working for A.J. Diani Construction for the next seven year, while he also worked as an Extra-help Juvenile Institutions Officer beginning in December 1989. Adolph was hired as a fulltime Juvenile Institutions Officer (JIO) in June 1997 at Los Prietos Boys Camp. He was known as the bus driver, which proved quite useful during several evacuations due to fires over the years. He also put his military experience to use by training and leading the camp color guard; and

WHEREAS, Adolph was instrumental in launching the Moral Reconation Therapy program at Los Prietos Boys Camp and regularly encouraged hard work and discipline by encouraging them to continue their education by planning field trips to local community colleges; and

WHEREAS, Adolph enjoys coaching youth softball and participating in the youth group at his church. He has been married to his wife Abby for 30 years, and has three wonderful daughters Adriana, Angela, and Alaynna; and

WHEREAS, Adolph is now looking forward to spending time with his family, hiking, playing softball, and continuing to support youth in his community. He has attained part time employment working for Santa Barbara Airbus and is interested in working as an Extra-help Juvenile Institutions Officer.
