Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the attached Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor with University of California, Santa Barbara (UCSB) (a local vendor) to provide program and process evaluations of female-specific services provided in the Santa Maria Juvenile Hall for FY 2017-18, with a total contract amount not to exceed \$36,000 (the "Agreement") (Attachment A); and
- B. Determine that the approval of the Agreement is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), finding that this activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment, and where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that this activity may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA, and direct staff to file a Notice of Exemption (Attachment B).

Summary Text:

The Agreement with UCSB will provide program and process evaluations of female-specific services provided in the Santa Maria Juvenile Hall in consultation with all agencies involved in providing these services (i.e., Probation, Behavioral Wellness, and Santa Barbara County Office of Education). This Agreement is funded by the Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act (JJCPA).

This is the fourth year UCSB will be evaluating female specific programs within the juvenile justice system, specifically the Santa Maria Juvenile Hall. This funding will allow UCSB to continue and build upon the work they started. They will evaluate procedures to address the educational and mental health needs of female youth in SMJH; monitor the implementation, fidelity and quality assurance of services being provided; conduct focus groups and online surveys of females in custody to obtain feedback for program improvement; and will conduct an evaluation of the juvenile probation system.

Background: The JJCPA (AB 1913, statutes of 2000) supports programs and services that address delinquency and problem behaviors among at-risk youth at the local level. Counties may use the State funds to support prevention, intervention, suppression, or custody programs based on local needs and as approved by a local Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council (JJCC). The JJCC reviews local programs and funding, and oversees the development of a comprehensive multidisciplinary local plan that is periodically updated to reflect current information.

Execution of the UCSB Agreement will provide program and process evaluations of female-specific services provided in the Santa Maria Juvenile Hall funded through JJCPA.
