Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve and Authorize the Chair of the Board to execute the attached agreement with the State of California, Department of Transportation, for the exchange of Federal Highway dollars for Non-Federal State Highway Account dollars, for Fiscal Year 2016/2017 apportionments in the amount of \$558,115;
- b) Authorize the Director of Public Works or designee to apportion these Regional Surface Transportation Program funds to the City of Buellton, the City of Guadalupe and the City of Solvang for FY 2016/2017, in the amounts established under Section 182.6(d)(1) of the Streets and Highways Code and by Santa Barbara County Association of Governments guidelines; and
- c) Determine that the proposed actions are administrative and other fiscal activities that do not involve commitment to any specific project, and are therefore not a project as defined by State California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines Section 15378 b(4), and approve and direct staff to file the attached Notice of Exemption on that basis.

Summary Text:

Each year, the County of Santa Barbara has the opportunity to exchange Federal Highway dollars for Non-Federal State Highway Account dollars through this agreement between the State and the County. This exchange is desirable as it gives the County the flexibility to use these funds for a wide range of transportation projects, from local road improvements to matching funds for other State or Federally funded projects. The Federal mandates associated with Federal funds are not applicable to funds

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converted to State Highway Account dollars; therefore, the only applicable federal restrictions are those specifically incorporated into the Agreement.

Your Board has approved similar exchange agreements each year since 1991. With the execution of this agreement, the County will receive the FY 2016/2017 apportionments in the amount of \$558,115.

Background:

Since the approval of the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA) in 1991, Santa Barbara County has been appropriated a sum of Federal funds annually, in an amount determined by the Federal Government. These federal funds were appropriated under the Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act (FAST). The County is permitted to exchange funds under Streets and Highways Code section 182.6(h) and these funds are shared between the County and Cities of the County, as determined by guidelines adopted by the Santa Barbara County Association of Governments (SBCAG).

By agreement, the County is responsible for collecting these funds on behalf of the City of Buellton, the City of Guadalupe, and the City of Solvang. Once the County receives the exchanged funds from the State, each of these Cities can request their portion directly from the County.

Narrative:

With the execution of this agreement, the County will receive \$558,115.00 to be deposited in Department 054, Fund 0015, Account 4320. Of this amount, the County will disperse \$72,214 to the City of Buellton, \$79,370 to the City of Solvang, and \$107,019 to the City of Guadalupe as identified for FY 2016/17. After disbursements, the County's share will be \$299,512.
