That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve and accept the highest Public Auction offer to purchase surplus heavy equipment at a Caterpillar sponsored auction and authorize the Purchasing Manager to prepare Bills of Sale and complete the transaction.
- b) Find that the submittal of surplus equipment for public auction does not constitute a "Project" within the meaning of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to 14 CCR 15378 (b)(5) (Organizational or administrative activities of governments that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment), and approve and direct staff to file the attached Notice of Exemption on that basis.

Summary Text:

This item in on the agenda in order to accept an offer of sales of surplus equipment. The Resource Recovery and Waste Management Enterprise Fund of the Public Works Department intend to submit for public auction (4) pieces of heavy equipment that have a combined minimum net sales value of \$150,000. These items are identified as one (1) 2004 914G Loader (serial #9WM028944), one (1) 2000 938G Loader (serial #6WS02304), one (1) 1995 D5HII Bulldozer (serial #8Rc06101), and one (1) 2005 D9T Bulldozer (serial #RJS00236). The auction will be conducted by Cat Auction Services.

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Background:

Section 2-47 of the County Code states that surplus items with a market value in excess of \$25,000 may only be disposed of by the Purchasing Manager with the prior approval of the Board of Supervisors.
