- HMIS: record, analyze, transmit homeless services data
- ServicePoint software
- HUD Continuum of Care Program (CoC Program)
- Santa Maria/Santa Barbara County Continuum of Care (CoC)



### HMIS - Background


- CoC Board
- HMIS Lead Agency: Housing and Community Development Division (HCD)
- \$5.9 million grant funding requires HMIS
- Limited coverage (50%)



- Organized by provider
  - 17 currently participating
- Provider staff enter data
  - Training and licenses
  - 57 provider staff entering data







  - Locally: Provider performance reports



### HMIS – Data Quality

- Reliability and validity
- Data generation
  - 17 providers; 57 staff members; 1,118 beds
- Data quality policies and procedures



### HMIS – Data Security

- Protect sensitive data
  - Mental health and medical information
- Limited access to HMIS
- Policies and procedures



#### HMIS – Performance Measures

- HUD System Performance Measures
- New metric, enacted 2016
- More data needed to assess CoC
- Coverage limitations
- Data quality management



## HMIS – Data Sharing

- Decided by CoC Board
- Data sharing currently "closed"
- Coordinated entry system (CES) January
   2018
- Move to "open" HMIS winter 2017
