The Emergency Permit authorizes grading and site restoration to stabilize an eroded slope and to rebuild an existing accessway that was partially destroyed in a mud slide caused by the storm event on February 17, 2017. The hillside will be reconstructed with an engineered 2:1 slope that will include a keyway, benching, and slope drainage. Grading will include approximately 1,000 cubic yards of total combined cut and fill activities for the reconstruction of drainage ditches and pipes, catch basins, rock channels, and erosion control benches in order to implement proper drainage. Upon completion, all exposed soil will be seeded and planted and storm water best management practices will be implemented where determined necessary in order to reduce and/or prevent future erosion.
