The Chimineas Ranch Foundation (CRF) is a IRS 501c3 non-profit corporation whose sole activity is the support of the Carrizo Plain Ecological Reserve (CPER), a California Department of Fish & Wildlife (CDFW) property.

This project will consist of the installation of 3 wildlife water troughs supplied by a new 5,000 gallon water tank. Water for the project will be supplied by an existing water line. The water line and an access road are located near the project area so off road access will not be necessary. The project will then be further extended thru the placement of additional pipeline other trough placements in what is known as the "Chicken Water Flats" area of Saltos Canyon. The project area has already been surveyed by a qualified archaeologist and no cultural resources were observed. This project is located within the Cuyama Valley hydrologic area and will benefit deer, tule elk, upland game and several bat species. The current drought situation in Southern California makes this wildlife water project a critical development on these CDFW lands and will improve the habitat of all wildlife per DFG 13103(e).

PART 4: BENEFITS TO SANTA BARBARA COUNTY WILDLIFE

Please describe how this project would directly or indirectly benefit Santa Barbara County's wildlife.

The CPER is located within the Cuyama Valley on the boundary between Santa Barbara County and San Luis Obispo County and includes a section of the Cuyama River. Wildlife populations within the Cuyama Valley habitat are by nature "dual citizens" of the two counties. Access permit records maintained by CDFW show that approximately 60% of the members of the public who are accessing the CPER in the area impacted by this project are Santa Barbara County residents. This project will directly relieve current serious drought impacts to these populations ranging from upland game to deer & elk and enhance those populations in better times.


