The second grant funds installation of 3 wildlife water troughs and placement of pipeline in the "Chicken Water Flats" are of Saltos Canyon. The third grant funds restoration of damaged habitat by removing two substantial barriers and one moderate impediment to steelhead migration in San Jose Creek.

Award of Fish and Wildlife Commission grant funds is a proposed budget allocation, and thus is a governmental fiscal activity, which does not involve any commitment to any specific project which may result in a potentially significant impact on the environment. There is no possibility that the approval of these three grants may have a significant effect on the environment.
