Justification: This budget revision decreases the budgeted revenue of \$298,714 from Other Financing Sources in the Public Health Department's Tobacco prevention

program and replaces it with Proposition 56 unanticipated revenue of \$298,714 from the California Tobacco Control Program (CTCP) for FY 2017-2018. On 9/19/17 the Board of Supervisors approved agreement CTCP-17-42 with CTCP. Since the increased Proposition 56 funding replaces the Tobacco Settlement Allocation Committee (TSAC) funding, TSAC will decrease funding to Tobacco prevention thus decreasing the transfer of committee funds to Health Care

Funds by \$298,714.

unanticipated revenues of \$2,400,792 from the 340B Contract Pharmacy Program. In addition, decrease budgeted release from Changes to Restricted

(\$1,066,021) as the additional unanticipated revenue will be used to cover program costs.

Justification: This budget revision is necessary to increase appropriations in the Public Health Care Fund for the replenishment of pharmaceuticals (\$1,234,771) for the

340B Pharmacy Program and for 340B refund payments to wholesalers (\$100,000). This unanticipated revenues (2,400,792) are funded by unanticipated revenues from the 340B Contract Pharmacy Program resulting from increased prescriptions of specialty drugs. Also, this unanticipated revenues will be used

to cover program costs resulting in decreased budgeted release from fund balance (\$1,066,021).

The amounts available in fund balance for the current fiscal year exceeded expenditures for the granting period. This entry releases fund balance and

reimburses the granting authority for funds not used that were budgeted in reimbursable overtime.

The funds for the project are still held within HCD's line of credit with the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). This

project slowed down after construction began unexpectedly and finishes in the current fiscal year without budget.
