

## **COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA CALIFORNIA**

RESOLUTION HONORING JACK OVERALL FOR HIS SERVICE TO SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

WHEREAS, Jack Overall and his wife Sheryl have lived in the Montecito portion Santa Barbara County for over 25 years, during which time he has demonstrated active volunteering, generous philanthropy and strong advocacy for a number of public and community organizations and their efforts; and

WHEREAS, in 2007, Mr. Overall was unanimously appointed by the County of Santa Barbara Board of Supervisors to serve as a Commissioner on the Montecito Planning Commission. During his ten-year tenure, he was elected both chair and vice chair. Commissioner Overall announced his retirement from the Commission in the spring of 2017; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Overall was appointed a member of the Santa Barbara County Association of Government's Milpas to Hot Springs 101 in Motion Project Stakeholders Group, where his years of service included citizen input regarding analysis of Santa Barbara's transportation needs; and

WHEREAS, his broad and dedicated volunteerism has led to his involvement and support of a number of philanthropic, civic, cultural and environmental organizations including Community Environment Council, the Land Trust for Santa Barbara County and the Santa Barbara Zoo, where he was elected to the board and served as president; and

WHEREAS, through numerous terms on the Board of Directors of the Montecito Association, Mr. Overall demonstrated active involvement in maintaining the unique character of Montecito. He served the Association as an officer, a member of the Executive Committee, Chair of the Land use Committee and led number of ad hoc committees focused on the betterment of his local community, and is being honored this year as the Montecito Association Citizen of the Year in recognition of his service; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors Jack Overall for his years of dedicated service to the citizens of Santa Barbara County.
