That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve the project as constructed and authorize the Chair to execute the attached Statement of Final Quantities for the FY 2016/2017 CDBG Isla Vista Sidewalk Improvements for work performed and materials supplied by Vince Lopez Jr. General Engineering Construction, (a local vendor), P.O. Box 488, Santa Maria CA, 93454, in the amount of \$434,234.37; and
- b) Determine the CDBG Isla Vista Sidewalk Improvement project was found by your Board to be exempt from the provisions of California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to State Guidelines Section 15301 on February 16, 2017, a Notice of Exemption was filed on that basis, and the proposed action is within the scope of the attached Notice of Exemption.

**Summary Text:**

This item is on the agenda to approve the project as constructed and the attached Statement of Final Quantities. This project consisted of the infill and construction of ADA compliant sidewalks in Isla Vista, while correcting the roadway drainage flow line along this stretch of roadway. This maintenance program is one of the methods used in our Road Maintenance Annual Plan (RdMAP) to provide safe travel conditions for pedestrians and traffic.

The Director of Public Works accepted this project as complete on August 25, 2017. This project was completed on budget.

**Background:**

This project was part of the 2017/18 RdMAP, and was constructed to develop a continuous pedestrian path on the north side of Sabado Tarde between Camino Corto and Camino del Sur. This process incorporates the construction and infill of sidewalks, and to correct drainage flow in the streets, while at the same time giving the public a better and safer way to travel through the neighborhood. This process includes bringing all of these facilities (driveways and pedestrian ramps) up to current ADA Standards.
