Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors recommend the following:

- a) Approve, ratify, and authorize the Chair to execute an Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor Easy Lift Transportation in an amount not to exceed \$72,309, that includes \$37,000 under Purchase Contract CN#21321 with Easy Lift Transportation but otherwise cancels, nullifies, and supersedes Purchase Contract CN#21321, to provide transportation services for the homeless population for the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018 (Attachment A).
- b) Determine that the recommended action is not a "project" within the meaning of the California Environmental Quality Act and is exempt per CEQA Guideline Section 15378(b)(4) since the recommended action is a government fiscal activity that does not involve commitment to any specific project which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment.

Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda to authorize the Chair to ratify and execute an Agreement with Easy Lift Transportation to provide transportation services for the homeless population in the County of Santa Barbara. The Public Health Department has a current purchasing contract with Easy Lift Transportation (Attachment B) for an amount not to exceed \$37,000, and the estimated expenditure for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 is \$72,309. This agreement incorporates a new stop for Behavioral Wellness services; \$7,309 of the contract increase will be paid for by Behavioral Wellness. When combined with existing

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contracts throughout other County departments for similar services, this contract for \$72,309 exceeds the \$100,000 Purchasing threshold and therefore requires Board approval.

Background:

Easy Lift Transportation has been providing transportation services for the Public Health Department, Health Care for the Homeless program for people experiencing homelessness for over ten years. Services include three scheduled round-trips from downtown shelters and homeless provider locations to County Services on the Calle Real Campus (Health Care Center, Behavioral Wellness, Social Services, and Veterans Services.)

This Board agreement will replace and augment the current purchase order agreement of \$37,000 by \$35,309 for a total contracted amount of \$72,309. The amount of \$65,000 is budgeted and is funded through Federal Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) funds for Healthcare for the Homeless grantee agencies. Behavioral Wellness will be invoiced for \$7,309 through the County's Journal Entry process.

Key Contract Risks:

This Agreement was assessed to be in a low risk category because:

- 1. The relatively small dollar amount and short contract term;
- 2. Easy Lift Transportation has demonstrated good performance with Public Health and other Santa Barbara County departments;
- 3. Program staff regularly assesses performance to determine if services are adequately provided;
- 4. Payment is provided after demonstration of reimbursable services; and
- 5. The Agreement has a termination for convenience clause.

The Public Health Department will continue to monitor this contract for any risks and in accordance with county policy.
