## Commercial Property Assessed Clean Energy Financing

October 18, 2016, the Board of Supervisors:

- Directed staff to pursue implementation of a third party administration model for commercial PACE; and
- Selected the California Statewide Communities Development Authority's (CSCDA) Open PACE program for administration of commercial PACE.







## Commercial Property Assessed Clean Energy Financing

On March 13, 2018 the Board:

- Adopted a resolution declaring the County's intention to make commercial PACE financing available to commercial property owners through the CSCDA Open PACE Program; and
- •Set a hearing for April 3, 2018 to consider CSCDA's report about the program and consider adoption of a resolution consenting to the implementation the CSCDA Open PACE program.







## Commercial Property Assessed Clean Energy Financing-Recommendations

- Adopt a resolution consenting to the implementation of the CSCDA Open PACE program;
- Approve and authorize the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute the CSCDA Agreement; and
- •Determine that the above recommended actions are not the approval of a project that is subject to environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(4)
