WHEREAS, Committed Week is a youth development campaign planned by youth for youth focusing on drug abuse prevention and education to promote a healthy and drug-free lifestyle; and

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse (CADA), Santa Barbara County Friday Night Live Partnership, and the Youth Service Specialist Program to involve families, schools, businesses, media, government, medical institutions, faith organizations, law enforcement agencies, and other youth organizations in all aspects of this campaign. This will foster an atmosphere that supports a healthy lifestyle for youth, and educates and creates awareness of the harms of substance abuse; and

WHEREAS, the Committed campaign was established by CADA to encourage our youth to live a healthy lifestyle through prevention efforts focused on promoting activities that keep youth drug free; and

WHEREAS, the month of April is California Friday Night Live Month and Alcohol Awareness Month, our Town Hall is a way to showcase student efforts to curb the effects of drugs and alcohol in the community; and
