Recommended Actions:

- a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the attached Agreement for Professional Legal Services between the County of Santa Barbara and the firm of Andrues/Podberesky in an amount not to exceed \$250,000 without written amendment; and
- b) Determine that the above action is not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Sections 15378(b)(4) and 15378(b)(5) because it consists of government administrative or fiscal activities that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.

Summary Text:

The County is a party to False Claims Act litigation pending in the United States District Court in Los Angeles. County Counsel recommends retaining the firm Andrues/Podberesky to represent the County in this litigation because Andrues/Podberesky: (1) has the expertise required by this highly-specialized area of practice, and (2) has offices near, and regularly practices in, the court where this litigation is pending. The proposed contract will authorize Andrues/Podberesky to represent the County in this one matter, within the contract's two-year term and \$250,000 limit. The County's excess insurer, CSAC-EIA, has confirmed that the costs of the County's representation by Outside Counsel in this matter will count toward satisfying the County's Self-Insured Retention (SIR).

The Office of County Counsel reviewed the Contract Risk Assessment Worksheet as part of our process.

Exhibit A of the Agreement ("Statement of Work") provides that the Board of Supervisors, acting through its County Counsel, expressly retains the authority to direct and control the course and conduct of the litigation, including the exclusive right to make decisions regarding settlement.

A Request for Proposals was not required for this selection. We interviewed representatives from this law firm and two others, all three of which were recommended by other public entities familiar with their work.
