




#### **Maintenance of Effort**





# Projected PCI vs. Funding



### Recommended Actions

#### **Recommendations:**

- Adopt the attached Resolution for the Measure A Five-Year Local Program
  of Projects for Fiscal Years 2018/2019 through 2022/2023, for submittal to
  the Santa Barbara County Local Transportation Authority for acceptance;
- Reaffirm the existing distributions of Measure A revenues: 50 percent population and 50 percent lane miles for the South Coast, and 100 percent lane miles for North County;
- Reaffirm Resolution 10-101, which establishes priorities and policies for the use of the local portion of the one-half cent sales tax for the transportation needs in Santa Barbara County;
- Direct staff to prepare Fiscal Year 2018/2019 Road Maintenance Annual Plan (RdMAP); and
- Determine that the proposed actions are administrative and other fiscal
  activities that do not involve commitment to any specific project, and are
  therefore not a project as defined by State CEQA Guidelines Section
  15378, and approve the filing of the attached Notice of Exemption on that
  basis.
