MATERNAL HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

WHEREAS, International Cesarean Awareness Network of Santa Barbara (ICAN-SB), Santa Barbara Birth Center, and Cottage Hospital are working towards improving statistics surrounding maternal health and values the health and safety of birthing women, mothers and families in Santa Barbara County; and

WHEREAS, Maternal Health Month is an awareness campaign planned by maternal, mental, and physical health organizations, including International Cesarean Awareness Network of Santa Barbara (ICAN-SB) to focus and promote improved care and results for the perinatal year, and longer; and

WHEREAS, it is the goal of ICAN-SB, Santa Barbara Birth Center, Cottage Hospital to bring awareness to families, schools, businesses, media, government, medical institutions, faith organizations, social change organizations, and other family and women's health organizations in order to foster an atmosphere that supports a healthy lifestyle for pregnant women and families, and educates and creates awareness of how to improve maternal health outcomes; and
