Project Title: Coastal Engineering Beach Profile Survey Professional Services Agreement

Project Description: Coastal Development Permit (CDP) No. 4-14-0687-A1 was issued in October 2017 for retention of a 1,200 foot revetment and 415 feet of sand and cobble-filled geotextile cells for a period of up to 20 years with certain conditions. These conditions include semi-annual beach profile surveys and an annual survey report performed by a coastal engineer. Approval of the professional agreement will allow the coastal engineer to complete the required Spring 2018, Fall 2018, Spring 2019 beach profile surveys along with the 2018 annual survey report in accordance with the permit requirements.



Reasons to support exemption findings (attach additional material, if necessary):

The Coastal Commission previously certified a Local Coastal Program for Santa Barbara County. As the decision-maker on the CDP Amendment, the Coastal Commission conducted environmental review, as necessary, pursuant to its certified state regulatory program. (Pub. Resources Code, § 21080.5.) This included analyzing any project alternatives or feasible mitigation measures, as appropriate, prior to CDP Amendment issuance.

Completion of beach profile surveys and the annual survey report in is accordance with the terms and conditions of the CDP Amendment approved and issued by the Coastal Commission, and is therefore in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), pursuant to California Public Resources Code section 21080.5 and CEQA Guidelines for Implementation of CEQA, 14 CCR Section 15002(l) and 15251(c) (certified regulatory plan in lieu of EIR).
