#### **Recommended Actions:**

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Approve, ratify, and authorize the Agricultural Commissioner or her designee to execute an agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture for support and services of compliance inspections related to the CalCannabis Licensing Division in the County of Santa Barbara for the period of May 1, 2018 through November 30, 2018 in the amount of \$24,280.08; and
- B. Determine that the proposed action involves government funding mechanisms and/or fiscal activities and is not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15378(b)(4) and direct staff to file a notice of exemption.

#### **Summary Text:**

This item is on the agenda for the Board of Supervisors to review and execute an agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) to receive reimbursement for the cost of all activities for a CDFA CalCannabis pilot project that will test commercial cannabis cultivation compliance inspections of licensed cultivation sites in Santa Barbara County.

#### **Background:**

In June 2017, the California Governor signed into law the Medicinal and Adult-Use Cannabis Regulation and Safety Act (MAUCRSA), which created one regulatory system for both medicinal and adult-use (recreational) cannabis. Under MAUCRSA, the CDFA was designated as the state agency responsible for issuing licenses to commercial cannabis cultivation in California. The Santa Barbara County Agricultural Commissioner in cooperation with CDFA CalCannabis Division may provide commercial cannabis cultivation inspections in support of the MAUCRSA for the CDFA CalCannabis program.
