RESOLUTION OF COMMENDATION FOR SHERIFF'S COMMANDER KELLY A. MOORE UPON HIS RETIREMENT FROM THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE

WHEREAS, Kelly A. Moore will be retiring from County service on Sunday, July 1, 2018, having faithfully served the Sheriff's Office for over 27 years, during which he served as a Sheriff's Corrections Officer, Sheriff's Deputy, Detective, Senior Deputy, Sergeant, Lieutenant and Commander; and

WHEREAS, Kelly A. Moore started his career with Santa Barbara County on November 12, 1984 as a Correctional Officer. On January 13, 1986 he was hired as a full-time Police Officer for the Carpinteria Police Department, where he served as an Officer, Detective and Corporal. On July 1, 1992 the Carpinteria Police Department transitioned to the Sheriff's Office, where he re-joined the Sheriff's Office as Detective. During his more than 33 years of law enforcement service in Santa Barbara County, he has worked in various capacities which included Corrections, Patrol, Criminal Investigations, Narcotics, Human Resources, and other various collateral assignments; and

WHEREAS, Kelly A. Moore, throughout his career provided the employees of the Sheriff's Office positive leadership and professionalism, as a positive representative of the Sheriff's Office and law enforcement profession. He has a distinguished career with some of the highlights being: involved in the Training Bureau burglary investigation, investigating the first known ecstasy lab in the United States, the Jesusita Fire and every major fire since 2009, the Isla Vista Riots of 2014, the Isla Vista Rapid Mass Murder investigation, the El Capitan Debris Flow and being one of the Unified Commanders during the 1/9 Debris Flow; and

WHEREAS, Kelly A. Moore provided the citizens of Santa Barbara County extraordinary professionalism and sensitive law enforcement service while dedicating his life to the pursuit of justice; and

WHEREAS, Kelly A. Moore's knowledge, skills and experience contributed greatly to the overall professionalism and the goals of the Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Office as well as the objectives of the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors commends Commander Kelly A. Moore for his faithful and distinguished service to the citizens of Santa Barbara County, congratulates him upon his retirement, and wishes him and his family, continued good health and many years of happiness.
