Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a. Accept a donation of \$105,911.83 from the Santa Barbara Special Enforcement Team Support Foundation, Inc. for replacement of Santa Barbara Sheriff's Office Special Enforcement Team (SET) equipment and for specialized training courses;
- b. Approve Budget Revision BJE-0005097 to increase appropriations of \$105,911.83 in Sheriff General Fund for capital assets (upgraded SET equipment) and SET training courses and funded by donation from the Santa Barbara Special Enforcement Team Support Foundation, Inc.; and
- c. Determine that the above actions are not a project pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(4), finding that the action is not a project as it is the creation of a government funding mechanism or other government fiscal activity, which does not involve any commitment to any specific project which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment.

Summary Text:

The Santa Barbara Special Enforcement Team Support Foundation, Inc. ("SET Foundation"), a non-profit organization not affiliated with the County of Santa Barbara, received donations to purchase and upgrade much needed equipment for SET as well as provide valuable training to our SET members. The

SET Foundation ordered the following equipment: an ASU- Airplane FLIR parts and monitor, a manual breaching door for SET training, upgraded SET weapons accessories as well as two tactical 4 shot launchers, and 2 single launchers with accessories such as carrying bags and cleaning systems for a total of \$61,751.74. The equipment is an upgrade as well as replacement of aging systems, and adds additional equipment for future training. Moreover, the donation from the SET Foundation will provide valuable training to SET members, in the amount of \$44,160.09, that need to remain on the cutting edge in tactical responses in the event of a callout.

Background:

The Sheriff's Office maintains the capability to respond to a myriad of threats, emergencies and other calls for assistance from the public and other public entities. The donation of the previously mentioned equipment and the valuable training will enhance SET's capabilities in responding to these threats to public safety. The equipment and training will provide the ability to keep SET on the cutting edge of training methods and new technology.

The Sheriff recommends that the Board of Supervisors accept this donation pursuant to section 25355 of the Government Code, section 18944 of title 2 of the California Code of Regulations, and section 610-D4.1 of the County Administrative Manual.
