Recommended Action(s):

That the Board of Supervisors considers the following actions:

- A. Receive the County Clerk, Recorder and Assessor/Registrar of Voters' certification of sufficiency of the *Initiative to Create a County of Santa Barbara Independent Redistricting Commission* (Attachment A), and either:
1. Adopt the ordinance without alteration at the July 3, 2018 Board Meeting at which the certification of the petition is presented, or within 10 days after it is presented; or
 2. Order the proposed ordinance to be submitted without alteration to the voters of the County at the November 6, 2018 Consolidated General Election by adopting the attached resolution (Attachment E) which includes direction to Auditor Controller to prepare a fiscal impact statement; or
 3. Order a report from appropriate staff agencies concerning the fiscal impacts, consistency with county plans, and any other matter of interest to the Board pursuant to Elections Code Section 9111, to be heard at the July 17, 2018 Board Meeting.
- B. If the Board orders the proposed ordinance be submitted to the voters (Action A-2), consider taking a position on proposed ordinance and appointing member(s) of the Board of Supervisors to author, sign

and submit on behalf of the Board a direct argument in favor or against the proposed ordinance and any possible rebuttal; and

- C. Determine that the proposed action is a submittal of a proposal to a vote of the people and not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(3).

Summary:

On May 15, 2018, the proponent of the Initiative to Create a County of Santa Barbara Independent Redistricting Commission filed a petition with the County Elections Office for signature verification. In accordance with the California Elections Code Sections 9114 and 9115, elections staff counted and verified the required number of signatures were valid. The County Clerk, Recorder and Assessor/Registrar of Voters' certification of sufficiency is affixed as Attachment A.

The full text of the proposed Initiative to Create a County of Santa Barbara Independent Redistricting Commission as submitted by the proponent is affixed as Attachment B.

For the Board's information, the title and summary of the proposed measure prepared by County Counsel is affixed as Attachment C and the language of California Elections Code Section 9111 as referenced in the recommended action(s) section is affixed as Attachment D.

If the Board orders a report pursuant to Elections Code Section 9111, then per Elections Code Section 9118, the report shall be presented to the Board of Supervisors not later than 30 days from the date of this July 3, 2018 meeting; however, due to summer recess, the last meeting at which the report(s) may be heard is the July 17, 2018 meeting. At the July 17 meeting the Board will then need to take action to adopt the ordinance without alteration or adopt a resolution ordering the proposed ordinance be submitted to the voters of the County at the November 6, 2018 Consolidated General Election.

The incremental cost for placing the measure on the November 6, 2018 Consolidated General Election is estimated to be between \$75,000-\$100,000. The higher amount in this range could be incurred if the full text of the measure is included in the ballot materials.
