#### **Recommended Actions:**

- Approve, ratify, and authorize the Chair to execute Amendment No. 1 with Stantec (a local vendor) adding federal clauses to their Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor providing flood control engineering services;
- b) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute an Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor with Stantec (a local vendor) to provide flood control engineering services for the period of August 28, 2018 through December 31, 2019 in the amount not to exceed \$500,000; and
- c) Determine that the contract amendment and the engineering contract are not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Guideline §15378 (b)(2), Not a Project.

#### **Summary Text:**

This item is on the agenda in order to approve an amendment and agreement with Stantec to include federal clauses in the contracts. The agreements provide for a variety of flood control engineering services including emergency engineering work on an as-needed, per project basis.

County Counsel worked with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), and the State Office of Emergency Services (CalOES), for the additional language required to be included in our existing contracts to be subject for state and federal reimbursement. This amendment will amend the

Stantec contract that has been used from January 8, 2018. The new agreement will be used for work performed from August 28, 2018 forward.

Stantec was hired in the immediate aftermath of the Thomas Fire and the 1-9 Debris Flow providing Graphical Information System (GIS) mapping experts to assist the County Office of Emergency Management (OEM) with mapping needs that were vital to operations.

To initiate work, Notices to Proceed will be issued by project and will specify tasks, deliverables, timelines, and budget. Each Notice to Proceed will be approved by the Public Works Director or designee.

### **Background:**

Stantec has extensive local engineering experience and is on the Public Works prequalified consultants list to provide flood control engineering services. Approving the new agreement will provide for continuation of ongoing services with Stantec through 2019.

### **Fiscal Analysis:**

Narrative:

Engineering costs are included in capital improvement projects as well as ongoing flood control programs. These projects are located throughout the County and are included in the County's Capital Improvement Program. These improvement projects are budgeted annually in the various Flood Zones. No General Fund monies will be utilized with this agreement.

This agreement will be used on an as-needed basis for routine and emergency flood control engineering services. No work is guaranteed by executing this agreement and the total not to exceed amounts are set at a high dollar amount in preparation for the potential need to respond to emergency situations.
