That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the attached Statement of Final Quantities for the 2017 San Jose Creek Bike Path Project; County Project No. 862085, Second Supervisorial District for work performed and materials supplied by Lash Construction, Inc., (a local vendor), 721 Carpinteria Street, Santa Barbara, CA 93103, in the amount of \$608,071.30;
- b) Find that pursuant to State California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines Section 15162, no substantial changes are proposed, and no new information of substantial importance has come to light regarding environmental effects of the project or of the sufficiency or feasibility of mitigation measures, and therefore the proposed actions are within the scope of the Mitigated Negative Declaration (14NGD-00000-00001), and Mitigation Monitoring Program adopted by the Board upon July 11, 2017, and therefore no new environmental document is required.

Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda to approve the project as constructed and the attached Statement of Final Quantities. The project is the construction of a 990-foot Class 1 bike path between Kellogg Avenue and Merida Drive.

On July 11, 2017, your Board awarded the above referenced construction contract to Lash Construction, Inc., and construction work began on August 28, 2017. The Director of Public Works accepted this project as complete on March 5, 2018. This project required a contract time extension of 9 total days due to the Thomas Fire and subsequent Debris Flow Incident, and was completed on budget.

Background:

The San Jose Creek Bike Path Project was included in the 1993 Goleta Community Plan and the 1999 Goleta Transportation Improvement Plan. The project site is approximately 1000 feet southwest of the Cathedral Oaks Road and Kellogg Avenue intersection, just north of the City of Goleta.

This project consists of a 990-foot bike path between Kellogg Avenue and Merida Drive. The path travels from Kellogg Avenue through the open space adjacent to the Kellogg Tennis Courts, over San Jose Creek and along the northern edge of University Open Space. The bike path also includes a 140-foot free-span bridge over San Jose Creek.

On August 25, 2015, your Board approved the Project and Mitigated Negative Declaration (14NGD-00000-00001), and Mitigation Monitoring Program pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and on July 11, 2017, authorized the Public Works to construct this project.

The total construction cost, including contingencies amount to \$608,071.30. Measure A Regional Bike and Pedestrian Program Grant, funded 66% of the project (\$400,000.00). The remaining 34%, (\$208,071.30) came from the GTIP funds from Dept. 054, Fund 0017, Program 2830, Org Unit 0600, Account 7510.
