Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A) Approve, ratify, and authorize the Chair to execute a First Amendment to the Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor with American Baptist Homes of the West dba Valle Verde Retirement Community (a local vendor) for provision of meals for the Psychiatric Health Facility and Crisis Stabilization Unit, to revise the contract language effective July 1, 2018 for FY 18-20 but with no change to the original maximum contract amount through June 30, 2020.
- B) Determine that the above actions are organizational and administrative activities of government that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment, and are therefore not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to section 15378(b)(5) of the CEQA guidelines.

Summary Text:

This item is on the Board's agenda to request an amendment to the Fiscal Years 2018-2020 contract for meals at the PHF and Crisis Stabilization Unit, to incorporate language revisions that reflect changes in

services that have been implemented by the County's Registered Dietician. Approval of the recommended actions will allow Behavioral Wellness to continue to provide ancillary food services at County mental health facilities.

Background:

American Baptist Homes of the West dba Valle Verde Retirement Community (Valle Verde) currently provides dietary services to the County's Psychiatric Health Facility including all meals as well as prepackaged frozen meals and floor stock items for the Crisis Stabilization Unit. Valle Verde has significant experience in providing institutional meal service and demonstrated compliance with applicable State and Federal requirements regarding food preparation and handling.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

None. There will be no changes to the original contract amount of \$468,000 (\$156,000 per year for a three year term).
