AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO THE AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES OF INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR WITH FILIPPIN ENGINEERING (BC 18-064)

Pursuant to Paragraph 25 of the Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor (hereinafter AGREEMENT) entered into on July11, 2017, as BC No. 18-064, between the Santa Barbara County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (hereafter COUNTY), and Filippin Engineering, having its principal place of business at 354 S. Fairview Ave., STE D, Goleta, CA 93117 (hereafter CONTRACTOR), the COUNTY and CONTRACTOR amend the AGREEMENT as provided in this Amendment 1:

WHEREAS, due to delays by Whitaker Construction Group, Inc. ("Whitaker") related to its completion of constructing the Unit II Channel Improvement Project ("PROJECT"), the PROJECT resulting in work extending 21 working days past that allotted for construction Phase 1; and

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 1 to the AGREEMENT was executed on January 23, 2018, accommodates a schedule splitting the PROJECT into two phases, changing the scope of work, increases the amount of compensation for the additional work by the CONTRACTOR, and remains unchanged and in full effect except as modified herein.

NOW THEREFORE, the COUNTY and CONTRACTOR do hereby agree as follows:

1. Exhibit A, Statement of Work is revised as follows:

Work as described in the Statement of Work from CONTRACTOR, attached as **EXHIBIT A2**, incorporated by this reference, hereby modifies the scope, scheduling and compensation of the work to be performed under AGREEMENT and Amendment No 1. The interpretation of EXHIBIT A2 shall take precedence over any conflict with the language In the AGREEMENT and Amendment No. 1.

2. Exhibit B, PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS, Paragraphs A and B are amended to read:

- **A.** For CONTRACTOR services to be rendered under this Agreement, CONTRACTOR shall be paid a total contract amount, including cost reimbursements, not to exceed \$299,001.19.
- **B.** Extra Work required to complete the project may be authorized only if CONTRACTOR receives written approval by the County's designated representative as identified in Paragraph 1 of the Agreement at the same rate per unit as defined in Attachment B1. The total amount of contingency fund is 10% of the agreement amount or \$29,900.11.

In all other respects, the AGREEMENT remains unchanged and in full effect.

Dear Ms. Sullivan,

Filippin Engineering, Inc. (FE) is submitting this Request for Additional Authorization to provide additional Construction Management and Inspection Services to the Santa Barbara County Flood Control & Water Conservation District for the Unit II Channel Improvements Project, pursuant to our conversations.

Subsequent to our budget revisions in October of 2017, the following items have caused an increase in the scope of services from that originally proposed:

- During Phase 1 Construction, Whitaker went 18 working days over their original schedule. Cost for CM and Inspection for these working days is approximately \$29,000.
- Due to the Contractor's increase in contract time (18 working days as noted above, and 59 working days added by CCO 1), the materials testing subconsultant, Fugro, has estimated that they will incur a cost of approximately \$5,000 over their budgeted amount.
- Between Phase 1 and Phase 2 Construction, additional coordination during the suspension including
 meeting the County's subcontractor to put up bird netting to discourage nesting birds, inspecting after
 the large storm events to measure and quantify the limits of damage in the channel, and participation in
 additional coordination and preconstruction meetings, resulted in extra costs of approximately \$12,000.

The FE total budget prior to the above request was \$253,001.19. Given the extra work outlined above, it is anticipated that should the Contractor use their total Phase 2 contract time, construction management and inspection could be an additional \$46,000, for a total cost of \$299,001.19. If the Contractor finishes early and the claims negotiation process is prompt, then actual costs will be less, and we will keep in close communication with you to inform you of any changes in this estimate based on Contractor performance or other project issues.
