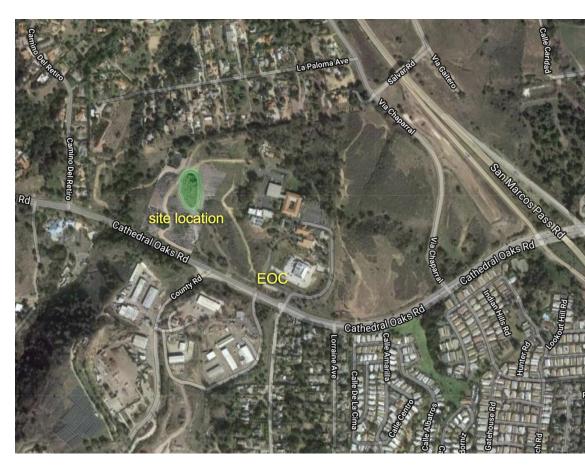
# Carpinteria Salt Marsh

- Material is left over from last winter
- After March storms,
  County agreed to cease
  emergency operations and
  finish in the Fall under
  existing permits



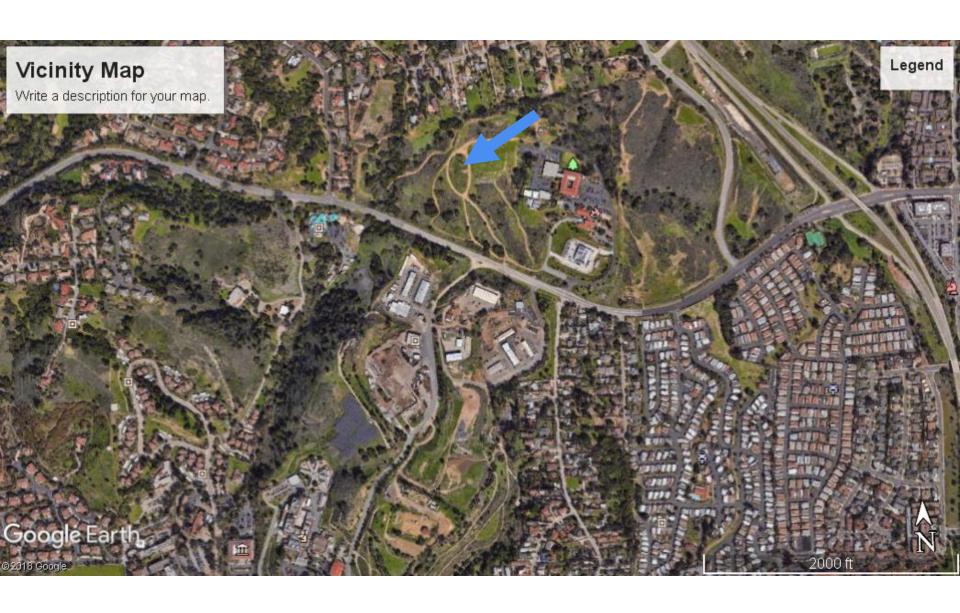
# Sediment Disposal

- As a continuance of last Winter, disposal options are limited.
  - Ventura County / Buellton disposal have high trucking costs and a per truck fee ~3 times the transportation cost
  - County Campus option far less cost and reduced environmental impacts

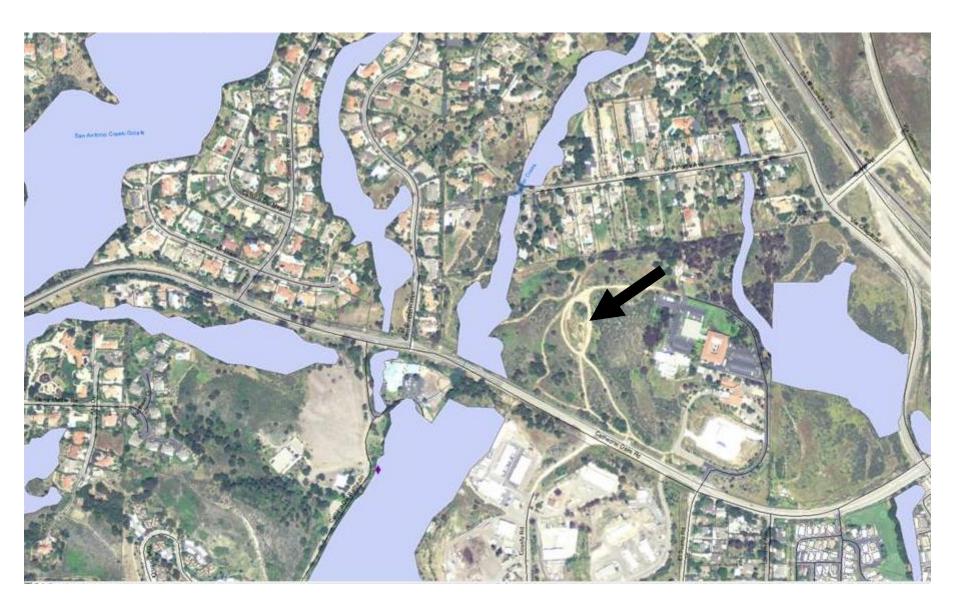


### Conclusions

- Continued concern over Sediment Management this winter and beyond.
- Authorize the Flood Control District to haul sediment from Carpinteria Salt Marsh to a temporary stockpile site on County owned property at 4400 Cathedral Oaks Road.
- Direct Public Works and General Services Departments to return to Board for update on long-term site acquisition status.
