That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve North Patterson Avenue Widening, County Project No. 862377 and authorize the Director of Public Works to advertise for construction; and
- b) Find the North Patterson Widening Project is exempt from the provisions of California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to 14 CCR 15301(c) (as the proposed project(s) consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that previously existing, including but not limited to existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities), and approve the filing of the attached Notice of Exemption on that basis.

Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda to approve the project and authorize the Director of Public Works or designee to advertise for bids to construct this project. This project will widen approximately 390 feet of the westerly portion of North Patterson Avenue beginning at Cathedral Pointe Lane and continuing south to meet up with a previously-widened section. Construction is anticipated to begin in November of 2018.

Background:

The Goleta Transportation Improvement Program (GTIP) lists the Patterson Avenue widening project as mitigation for development in the Eastern Goleta Valley. This project will create a continuous two-lane road in both directions on the North Patterson Avenue corridor from US Highway 101 to Cathedral Oaks Road. It consists of removing existing asphalt shoulder and constructing a new travel lane, a retaining

wall, curb, gutter, and sidewalk on the west of Patterson Road. The southern limits of the project will connect with the new Tree Farm Subdivision located just north of Agana Drive on Patterson Avenue.
