### **Recommended Actions:**

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a. Approve and authorize the Chair to execute an Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor with KNN Public Finance, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 per year and a total contract amount not to exceed \$150,000 for on-call municipal advisory services, with two 1-year options to renew (Attachment A); and
- b. Approve Budget Journal Entry #0006007 appropriating \$50,000 in expenditures from fund balance (Attachment C); and
- c. Determine that the above action is not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(5), because it is a government fiscal activity which does not involve commitment to any specific project which may result in potentially significant physical impact on the environment.

#### **Summary Text:**

This agreement is for the firm of KNN Public Finance, LLC to provide municipal advisory services as requested by the Treasurer-Tax Collector. Municipal Advisors have specialized expertise in municipal debt issuance and perform such duties as analyzing financial markets, preparing debt service analyses,

evaluating debt structuring alternatives and assisting in developing financing plans for capital projects. This agreement will give the Treasurer-Tax Collector the flexibility to use KNN as needed in future debt issuances.

KNN Public Finance, LLC has been providing the Treasurer-Tax Collector and Public Works with financial advisory services related to the financing of the proposed Tajiguas Resource Recovery Project.

### Narrative:

This agreement for on-call municipal advisory services is not to exceed \$50,000/year for 3 years for a total contract amount of \$150,000 with two 1-year options to renew. When the Treasurer-Tax Collector decides to move forward with a debt issuance, the agreement will be amended to provide for KNN to be paid a transaction fee and other expenses from the proceeds of the new debt issuance.

The Treasurer-Tax Collector views this contract as low risk because KNN Public Finance, LLC is highly experienced in financial matters and has worked with the Treasurer-Tax Collector for multiple years.
