- D. Whereas on May 15, 2018, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara, by Resolution No. 18-115 directed County staff to withdraw and resubmit said amendment for consideration and certification to the California Coastal Commission; and
- E. Whereas on August 10, 2018, the California Coastal Commission approved a resolution of certification with suggested modifications for this amendment to the County's Local Coastal Program (Coastal Commission Case No. LCP-4-STB-18-0039-1-Part B); and
- F. Whereas the Board of Supervisors finds the suggested modifications to be acceptable.
