RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING OCTOBER 23RD - 31ST, 2018 RED RIBBON WEEK IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

WHEREAS, Red Ribbon Week is the longest-running nationwide campaign for drug abuse prevention and education, promoting healthy, drug-free lifestyles; and

WHEREAS, this annual effort during the last week of October by the Friday Night Live program offers our students the opportunity to demonstrate their commitment to drug-free lifestyles by promoting visible, unified prevention and education efforts; and

WHEREAS, California Friday Night Live was developed in 1984 as a state-wide model program to reduce alcohol use and other problems among young people by building partnerships for positive and healthy youth development that engages youth as active leaders and resources in their communities; and

WHEREAS, The Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse has hosted Santa Barbara County Friday Night Live since 1986 to provide local students leadership opportunities to prevent the use and abuse of alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs; and

WHEREAS, schools, government agencies, law enforcement, local businesses, religious institutions, service organizations, families, and youth will demonstrate their commitment to healthy, drug-free lifestyles through school and community campaigns; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors proclaims October 23rd to 31st Red Ribbon Week in Santa Barbara County and encourages all residents to support and participate in alcohol and other drug prevention activities to celebrate this year's theme, "Life Is Your Journey. Travel Drug FreeTM".
