That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Accept a donation of equipment and cost of installation, valued at \$31,357.65, from the Project Rescue Flight, a non-profit 501(c)(3) corporation to the Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Office, Air Support Unit:
- b) Approve Budget Revision BJE-0006040 to increase appropriations in Sheriff General Fund for capital assets (upgraded search light) and funded by a donation from the Project Rescue Flight; and
- c) Find that the proposed action does not constitute a "Project" within the meaning of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), pursuant to 14 CCR 15378 (b)(5), in that it is a government administrative activity that will not result in direct or indirect changes in the environment.

Summary Text:

Project Rescue Flight, a non-profit organization, has recently approved the purchase of an upgraded search light that will improve and enhance the County Air Support Units capabilities. This search light, once approved, will be installed in "Copter 2", one of the Air Support Unit's OH-58 helicopters. This helicopter is utilized for law enforcement missions, search and rescue operations, as well as fire mapping and overflight operations. The upgraded search light will improve the Air Support Unit's

ability to locate and track fleeing suspects, find lost or missing persons, and observe areas of potential or actual threat of natural disaster during the hours of darkness.

Background:

County Policy D4.1 requires that departments submit donation requests to the Board of Supervisors. Project Rescue Flight, a 501(c)3 non-profit, fund-raising organization, has donated equipment and specialized services to the Sheriff's Air Support Unit (ASU) for many years. This has included significant contributions towards the development and deployment of state-of-the-art rescue and firefighting helicopters.

The Project Rescue Flight Board of Directors has identified the above detailed items as being needed to improve or enhance the operations at the Sheriff's Air Support Unit.
