WHEREAS, Sandy has spent her career in public service helping constituents get the help they need; and

WHEREAS, Sandy took the lead organizing Santa Barbara County Stand Down from day one, traveling to San Diego to meet with original Stand Down coordinators to learn their process; and

WHEREAS, Sandy has worked with governmental agencies, non-profits, active-duty military, veterans and the business community to build a coalition of support services for veterans; and

WHEREAS, Sandy has grown Stand Down from the first year in which a single building was used and 230 veterans attended to an event with expanded services throughout Santa Maria Fairpark that draws more than 600 volunteers, 100 service partners and 500 veterans and their families; and

WHEREAS, Supervisor Lavagnino has stated that without Sandy there is no Stand Down.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED, that this Board of Supervisors honors and commends Sandy Agalos for her service to the veteran community.
