#### **Recommended Actions:**

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a. Set a public hearing on the Departmental Agenda for December 4, 2018 to hold a community forum, as required by Government Code section 7283.1(d), regarding ICE's access to individuals, and to receive and consider public comment; and
- b. Determine this action is exempt from California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15378(b)(5), which are organizational or administrative activities of governments that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes to the environment.

### **Summary Text:**

The community forum is a requirement of Government Code section 7283.1(d) and this action will set a public hearing on December 4, 2018 to meet this requirement.

# **Background:**

Government Code Section 7283.1(d), of the TRUTH Act, requires the Board of Supervisors to hold at least one community forum annually, with at least 30 days of notice, "to provide information to the public about ICE's access to individuals and to receive and consider public comment."
