#### TO AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES OF INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

This is an amendment (hereafter referred to as the "Second Amended Contract") to the Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor, referenced as number <u>BC 17-035</u>, by and between the **County of Santa Barbara** (County) and **The Salvation Army Southern California Division** (Contractor), wherein Contractor agrees to provide and County agrees to accept the services specified herein.

Whereas, this Second Amended Contract incorporates the terms and conditions set forth in the contract approved by the County Board of Supervisors in June 2016 and the First Amendment approved by the County Board of Supervisors in August 2018, except as modified by this Second Amended Contract;

Whereas, due to the delay in Drug Medi-Cal (DMC) certification by the Contractor to allow for the provision of alcohol and drug program services under the new Organized Delivery System (ODS) and to prevent a gap in non- DMC Alcohol and Drug Program (ADP) services currently provided by the Contractor, the Contract termination date will be extended to June 30, 2019. Upon receipt of Drug Medi-Cal certification, the ADP portion of this contract will be terminated and replaced by a new Board Contract for Contractor to provide DMC ODS services.

Whereas, the Contractor will provide a greater number of services than contemplated by the original Agreement and will incur expenses beyond the value of this Agreement, this amendment adds additional funds up to **\$24,000** for Fiscal Year 18-19, for a new multiyear Agreement maximum not to exceed **\$341,100** so as to compensate Contractor for additional services to be rendered under this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

#### I. In the Agreement Section 4. Term, delete Section 4 and replace with the following:

4. Term.

Contractor shall commence performance on 7/1/2016 and end performance upon completion, but no later than 6/30/2019 unless otherwise directed by County or unless earlier terminated.

For Alcohol and Drug Free Housing services set forth in Exhibit A-1 ADP, Contractor shall commence performance on July 1, 2016 and end performance upon the effective date for Contractor's provision of Drug Medi-Cal certified Organized Delivery System services, but no later than June 30, 2019, unless otherwise directed by County or unless earlier terminated.

#### II. Delete Section I. of Exhibit B, Financial Provisions, and replace with the following:

 For Contractor services to be rendered under this Agreement, Contractor shall be paid at the rate specified in the Schedule of Rates (Exhibit B-1-ADP and Exhibit B-1-MH), with a maximum value not to exceed \$113,700 for FY 2016-2017, \$113,700 for FY 2017-2018, and \$113,700 for FY 2018-2019. The total contract amount payable for Fiscal Years 2016-2019 shall not exceed \$341,100, inclusive of \$144,000 in Alcohol and Drug Program funding, and \$197,100 in Mental Health funding.
