WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Sections 21354, 22503 and 22507 and the Code of Santa Barbara County, California, Sections 23-1 and 23-11, authorize the Board of Supervisors of the County, to establish stop intersections, or parking regulations on portions of roads and highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of public safety that certain portions of County highways in Santa Barbara County be designated as stop intersections or no stopping, standing, or parking zones, in accordance with said Sections;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that the following locations in Santa Barbara County and under the jurisdiction of the Board of Supervisors of said County are hereby designated as stop intersections, angle parking zones, handicapped parking zones or no stopping, standing, or parking zones and that the Director of Public Works of the County of Santa Barbara is hereby authorized and directed to install and maintain appropriate pavement markings and signs at the following locations.

Stop Control

• Stop Yaple Avenue at its intersection with Walnut Park Drive.

No Stopping, Standing, or Parking (7 am to 3 pm school days) Zone

- On the south side of Sandalwood Drive from a point 233 feet west of the centerline of Pinewood Road to a point 313 feet west of the centerline of Pinewood Road.
- On the north side of Dahlia Place from a point 129 feet east of the centerline of Loch Lomond Drive to a point 322 feet east of the centerline of Loch Lomond Drive.

No Stopping, Standing, or Parking (7 am to 4 pm school days) Zone

• On the south side of Sandalwood Drive from a point 659.5 feet west of the centerline of Pinewood Road to a point 852.5 feet west of the centerline of Pinewood Road.

No Stopping, Standing, or Parking Zones

- On the north side of Via Real from the centerline of Toro Canyon Road to a point 130 feet east of the centerline of Toro Canyon Road.
- On the south side of Sandalwood Drive from a point 379.5 feet west of the centerline of Pinewood Road to a point 407.5 feet west of the centerline of Pinewood Road.
- On the south side of Sandalwood Drive from a point 599.5 feet west of the centerline of Pinewood Road to a point 659.5 feet west of the centerline of Pinewood Road.

90 Degree Angle Parking Zone

• On the south side of Sandalwood Drive from a point 407.5 feet west of the centerline of Pinewood Road to a point 599.5 feet west of the centerline of Pinewood Road.

Handicapped Parking Zone

• On the south side of Sandalwood Drive from a point 418.5 feet west of the centerline of Pinewood Road to a point 450.5 feet west of the centerline of Pinewood Road.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Santa Barbara County Director of Public Works or designee is hereby authorized and directed to install appropriate markings and/or signs at said locations as time and resources permit.
