#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY & DISCUSSION:**

Item No. 11-02-01 **Speed Zones in Various Locations** (First, Second, Third, Fourth Districts) **Request: Speed Zone Update** 

The County's Traffic Section has reviewed the speed limits on several streets within the unincorporated area of the county. The streets analyzed were Channel Drive, Las Palmas Drive, Vereda Levenda, Refugio Road, Burton Mesa Boulevard, Clark Avenue, Foxenwood Lane, and Union Valley Parkway. The attached ordinance reflects the recommendations by the Traffic Engineering Committee for these streets.

Subject: Speed Zones TEC Proceedings of 11/14/02 - Various Rds /Set Hearing

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All recommended changes would be enforceable by radar, in compliance with State law. Therefore, in accordance with the California Vehicle Code, the Public Works Department recommends the following proposed speed limits:
