Approve, ratify, and authorize the Agricultural Commissioner, or her designee, to execute an amendment to an agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) for support and services of compliance inspections related to the CalCannabis Licensing Division in the County of Santa Barbara for the period of May 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 in the amount of \$24,280.08.

#### Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda for the Board of Supervisors to review and execute an agreement with the CDFA to extend the current agreement period to June 30, 2019, so as to receive reimbursement for the cost of all activities for a CDFA CalCannabis pilot inspection project that will test commercial cannabis cultivation compliance inspections of licensed cultivation sites in Santa Barbara County.

#### **Background:**

In June 2017, the California Governor signed into law the Medicinal and Adult-Use Cannabis Regulation and Safety Act (MAUCRSA), which created one regulatory system for both medicinal and adult-use (recreational) cannabis. Under MAUCRSA, the CDFA was designated as the state agency responsible for issuing licenses to commercial cannabis cultivation in California. The Santa Barbara County Agricultural Commissioner in cooperation with CDFA CalCannabis Division may provide Page 2 of 2

commercial cannabis cultivation inspections in support of the MAUCRSA for the CDFA CalCannabis program.
