- a) That the Board of Supervisors approves the attached proposed amendment to the Conflict of Interest Code of Santa Barbara Metropolitan Transit District ("District"); and,

Summary Text:

The District's Conflict of Interest Code amendments were adopted September 18, 2018. The amendments were done to comply with legislative updates. (See Attachment A-2018 Local Agency Biennial Notice; and Attachment B- December 4, 2018 letter with District Minutes from September 18, 2018, including amended Conflict of Interest Code in strikethrough format.

Background:

All public agencies are required by the Political Reform Act of 1974 to:

- 1. Adopt local conflict of interest codes identifying the reporting requirements of covered employees; and,
- 2. Review the need for any revisions to their local conflict of interest codes on a biennial basis.

The Political Reform Act designates Boards of Supervisors as the local Code Reviewing Body for independent districts and agencies. Government Code Section 82011. The revised Conflict of Interest Code is effective once approved by your Board. Government Code Section 87303.
