SUBJECT: Amendment to the Conflict of Interest Code of the Partnership Schools of the Central Coast (previously known as - Family Partnership Charter School)

Summary Text:

The Partnership Schools of the Central Coast's Conflict of Interest Code amendments were adopted April 24, 2018. The amendments were done to: include new positions; revise the titles of existing positions; delete titles of positions that have been abolished and/or positions that no longer make or participate in making governmental decisions; and to insert new corporate name. (See Attachment A – 2018 Local Agency Biennial Notice; and Attachment B – April 24, 2018 Partnership Schools of the Central Coast Minutes, including amended Conflict of Interest Code in strikethrough format and a clean copy.

Background:

All public agencies are required by the Political Reform Act of 1974 to:

1. Adopt local conflict of interest codes identifying the reporting requirements of covered employees; and,

2. Review the need for any revisions to their local conflict of interest codes on a biennial basis.

The Political Reform Act designates Boards of Supervisors as the local Code Reviewing Body for independent districts and agencies. Government Code Section 82011. The revised Conflict of Interest Code is effective once approved by your Board. Government Code Section 87303.
