

HOOP STRUCTURES ORDINANCE AMENDMENT

Hoop Structures & Shade Structures

- County Building Code
 - Exempt from Building Permits
- County Land Use and Development Code (LUDC)
 - Lack of Clarity, Conflicting Regulations
- Board of Supervisors
 - Long Range Planning Work Program

Planning Commission Recommendation Summary

- □ Allow Crop Protection Structures in AG Zones
- Exempt Crop Protection Structures
 - 20 ft. or less in height
 - No permanent structural elements, lighting, plumbing, etc.
 - Located on historically intensively cultivated ag land
 - Located on slopes averaging 20% or less
 - □ 4,000 sq. ft. in area or less if located in:
 - Santa Ynez Valley Design Control (D) Overlay
 - Gaviota Coast Critical Viewshed Corridor (CVC) Overlay
- □ Otherwise Permit is Required

Environmental Review Overview

- Notice of Preparation
- Program Environmental Impact Report (EIR)
- Analyzed Impacts Resulting from Placement & Use of Hoop & Shade Structures
- □ Did Not Analyze Impacts of Cultivation
- Key Mitigation Measures to Reduce Impacts to Level
 Appropriate for Permit Exemption

EIR Impacts Summary

- □ Class I Significant and Unavoidable
 - Aesthetics/Visual Resources
 - Resources Recovery/Solid Waste
- □ Class II Significant and Mitigable
 - Water Resources-Flooding
 - Biological Resources
- Class III Less than Significant
 - Land Use
 - Agricultural Resources
 - Water Resources-Water Quality, Groundwater, Runoff

Planning Commission Summary Recommended Revisions

- Reject 2 Mitigation Measures as Infeasible
- Delete 2 Mitigation Measures as Unnecessary
 based on New Evidence
- □ Revise 3 Mitigation Measures
- Revise Critical Viewshed Corridor (CVC) OverlayRequirement
- Add Slopes Criterion

MM-VIS-1 Height & Setback

- 12-ft. Height Limit within 75 ft. of Public Roads to
 Qualify for Exemption
 - Reduces visual impacts from public roads, Scenic Highways
- Planning Commission: Reject as Infeasible
 - Economic burden
 - Farming inefficiencies
 - Increased costs

MM-VIS-2 Urban Township Setback

- Setback 400 ft. from 9 Unincorporated Townships
 Unless Not Visible from Public Areas
 - Reduces visual impacts to visual character of townships
- □ Planning Commission: Reject as Infeasible
 - Economic burden
 - Farming Inefficiencies
 - Increased costs

MM-VIS-3 Design Control (D) Overlay

- □ 4,000 sq. ft. Size Limit within Santa Ynez Valley
 - D Overlay Unless Not Visible from Public Areas
 - Reduces visual impacts of large exempt structures in Santa Ynez Valley D Overlay
- Planning Commission: Revise Measure
 - 4,000 sq. ft. Permit Threshold
 - Exempt 4,000 sq. ft. or less
 - □ Permit required over 4,000 sq. ft.

CVC Overlay Requirement

- 4,000 sq. ft. <u>Size Limit</u> within Gaviota Coast Plan
 CVC Overlay
 - Reduces impacts to critical views from U.S. 101
- Planning Commission: Revise Requirement
 - 4,000 sq. ft. Permit Threshold
 - Exempt 4,000 sq. ft. or less
 - □ Permit required over 4,000 sq. ft.

MM-WR-1 Crop Protection Structures Within a Floodway

- □ Not Allowed with Exemption when in a Floodway
 - Reduces flooding impacts associated with location in a floodway
- Planning Commission: Delete Measure based on New Evidence
 - Flood Control District Letter & Testimony
 - Does not recommend floodway regulatory measures for hoop structures
 - Measure not required

MM-BIO-1 Limit Exemption to Historically Intensively Cultivated Agricultural Lands

- Limit Exemption to Historically Intensively Cultivated Agricultural Lands
 - Reduces impacts to biological resources
 - Grazing lands and lands not recently intensively cultivated may support protected biological resources
- Within 3 of the Previous 5 Years
- Planning Commission: Revise Timeframe
 - To "1 year of the previous 3 years"
 - USFWS can support this revision
 - CDFW prefers original timeframe

MM-BIO-2 Minimum One-Foot Gap between Ground and Plastic Cover

- Requires Minimum 1-ft. Gap between Ground and Plastic within 1.24 miles of CA Tiger Salamander (CTS) Breeding Ponds
 - Reduces impacts to CTS
- Planning Commission: Delete Measure based on New Evidence
 - Additional USFWS information
 - Gap would not mitigate impacts to CTS

MM-BIO-3 Streams and Creeks Setbacks

- Requires Setbacks from Streams and Creeks
 - 100 ft. Rural Areas
 - 50 ft. Urban Areas, Inner-Rural Areas, EDRNs
 - Reduces impacts to riparian habitat and species that depend on riparian habitats
- Planning Commission: Revise Measure
 - Change Rural Area setback to 50 ft.
 - 100-ft. setback must still apply where required by community plan policy

Add Slopes as Exemption Criterion

- □ Not Part of Original Project Description or Mitigation
- Planning Commission: Add Slopes as Exemption

Criterion

- Exempt on Slopes Averaging 20% or Less
- Require Permit on Slopes Greater 20%

Planning Commission Recommendation

- Make Findings for Approval
- Certify Final EIR with Revision Document RV 01
- Adopt Ordinance Amending LUDC
