**PROHIBIT HOOP STRUCTURES for CANNABIS!** This critical restriction would eliminate multiple, countywide problems. Tepusquet Community advocated for this from the outset. We have advocated for *many other restrictions*, throughout this entire process.

#### It was never the intention of Santa Barbara County to:

- Use Hoop Structures for, "SOME HIGH INTENSITY PURPOSE."
- Allow lighting or heating or *any* mechanical devices in hoop houses
- Allow Cannabis development to occur everywhere *or* on every parcel

### CANNIBIS GROWERS use Hoop Structures/Houses, *primarily, for* ONE PURPOSE: To *Manipulate* Plants so they can Profit by Producing Three to Six Crops per Year!

BERRY FARMERS also use hoop houses for 'climate control,' <u>to protect their crops.</u> BERRY FARMERS *do not* require use of power to light, heat, ventilate, etc., crops. BERRY FARMERS *do not* manipulate plants to generate multiple crops per year. BERRY FARMERS *do not* grow crops on steep hillsides or in isolated regions. BERRY FARMERS DO NOT CAUSE PUBLIC OUTCRY or GENERATE COMPLAINTS!

### COMMERCIAL INDUSTRY GROWERS ARE NOT GOOD NEIGHBORS! They not only cause Public Outcry but COUNTYWIDE-OUTRAGE!

### CANNIBIS INDUSTRY GROWERS:

- Compromise SBC's Future by developing a Controversial, Offensive Industry
- Develop on steep hillsides, steep slopes and along scenic highways and byways
- Abuse SBC by failing to comply with County, State and Federal Regulations
- Abuse neighbors, communities and legit growers by ignoring County Ordinances
- Grow plants that produce an offensive ODOR that reeks like DEAD SKUNKS
- Have Numerous Violations re unpermitted Grading, Fish & Wild, Lighting, etc.

- Develop in isolated areas, where they are *mostly*, 'unregulated & unenforced' *Need I add more???*

- LIMIT NUMBER of ACRES for CULTIVATION, regardless of parcel size
- LIMIT NUMBER of CANNABIS PERMITS/LICENSES, issued to GROWERS
- TODAY PROHIBIT CANNABIS in HOOP STRUCTURES, PERIOD!





### Tepusquet Canyon - Before and After





