### LONG RANGE PLANNING DIVISION FY 2018-2019 WORK PROGRAM - CHANGES

- First Quarter filled four vacancies
- New mandates/changes in State law
  - OPR changes to the State CEQA Guidelines
  - State housing and density bonus legislation



## LONG RANGE PLANNING DIVISION FY 2018-2019 WORK PROGRAM - CHANGES

- Projects added to the Work Program:
  - "Rodeo"/Union Valley Parkway Road Extension
    - One-time funding from cannabis tax revenue: increase from \$155,800 to \$320,000
  - Utility Grade Solar Ordinance Amendments
  - Short-Term Rentals Coastal Ordinance Amendments
  - Additional Cannabis Ordinance Amendments



### LONG RANGE PLANNING DIVISION FY 2018-2019 WORK PROGRAM - CHANGES

- Existing projects requiring unanticipated work:
  - Gaviota Coast Plan
  - Hoop Structures Ordinance Amendments
  - AEDs Ordinance Amendments
  - ECAP new GHGs emissions reduction target, and regional approach



## LONG RANGE PLANNING DIVISION FY 2018-2019 - ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Completed Projects:
  - Cannabis Land Use Ordinance and Licensing Program
  - Eastern Goleta Valley Community Plan ESH/RC and Vegetation Maps
  - ECAP GHGs Emissions Inventory
  - Gaviota Coast Plan
  - Montecito Design Guidelines Phase II



## LONG RANGE PLANNING DIVISION FY 2018-2019 — ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Substantial Progress:
  - Board approved, but Coastal Commission certification pending:
    - ADUs Ordinance Amendments; inland ordinance complete/operative
    - Coastal Resiliency Project
    - AEDs Ordinance Amendments; inland ordinance complete/operative



### LONG RANGE PLANNING DIVISION FY 2018-2019 - ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Substantial Progress:
  - Coastal Short-Term Rentals Ordinance Amendments
  - Hoop Structures Ordinance Amendments: likely adoption on April 9, 2019
  - Hollister Avenue State Street streetscape plans: completion within this fiscal year

#### Considerations for Developing the FY 2019-2020 Work Program



- Purposes of the Long Range Planning Division Work Program:
  - Receive public and other stakeholder input
  - Review on-going projects
  - Select projects and activities that warrant funding and staff allocation in the P&D budget
  - Identify potential projects for future work programs



- Considerations when developing the Work Program:
  - Budgetary constraints no increase in staffing
  - Multi-year projects require continued support for completion
  - State mandated projects
  - Public and interest group requests
  - Focus on countywide projects



- Three components of the Long Range Planning Division Work Program:
  - Required services and operations
  - On-going projects from the FY 2018-2019 Work Program
  - Recommended new projects

- Renew '22 Long Range Planning Division Work Program initiatives:
  - Assess the number of projects in the Long Range Planning Division
  - Review staffing needs to effectively complete projects
  - Investigate alternative funding methods



- Renew '22 Long Range Planning Division Work Program initiatives:
  - Demands for projects exceed staffing resources
  - Alternative funding mechanisms:
    - Grant applications: CalOES grant application (\$150,000)
    - Increase general plan surcharge on building permits: currently \$200,000/year; 1% increase = \$40,000 additional/year



- Recommended new projects:
  - None
  - Staffing resources are fully allocated with required services, operations, and on-going projects



- Future work programs:
  - Continue to prioritize completion of existing projects
  - Focus on Comprehensive Plan Elements and other projects with countywide benefits
    - Open Space Element (1991)
    - Environmental Resources
      - Management Element (1991)
    - Agricultural Element (1991)

- Noise Element (1997)
- Conservation Element (2010)
- Land Use (2011)



- Montecito PC Hearing (February 20, 2019)
  - Requested a Work Program report to occur in the fall
  - No changes to the recommended Work Program



- County PC Hearing (February 27, 2019)
  - Requested a Work Program report to occur in the fall
  - Requested staff "briefings" for direction on significant amendments and policy development
  - No changes to the recommended Work Program



- Agricultural Advisory Committee
  - Process farmstays amendments with the Agricultural Tiered Permitting Project
- Montecito Association
  - Developing a list of potential amendments to the Montecito Community Plan
- WE Watch
  - Lighting ordinance amendments



#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION

- (1) Determine that the Board of Supervisors' action is not a "project" that is subject to environmental review pursuant to the State CEQA Guidelines [§ 15378(b)(5)];
- (2) Provide direction to staff regarding any desired increases in funding for Long Range Planning Division projects; and
- (3) Allocate the funding and staff resources during budget adoption to continue to provide required services, conduct operations, and work on projects with remaining work from the FY 2018-2019 Work Program.
