Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Find, in accordance with Government Code § 31000, that the County does not have employee resources to complete the custodial work to be completed by Big Green Cleaning Company and that the County's economic interests are served by the attached contracts;
- b) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the attached Third Amendment to BC17-228 with Big Green Cleaning Company (a local vendor) increasing the total contract amount by \$2,756,652.00 for a total contract amount not to exceed \$5,453,372.00;
- c) Authorize the Director of General Services to approve amendment to BC17-228 with Big Green Cleaning Company in the amount not-to-exceed \$272,668.60 (5% of Contract); and
- d) Determine that the above actions are not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15378(b)(5) of the CEQA guidelines because they consist of organization or administrative activities of governments that will not result in direct or indirect changes in environment.

Summary Text:

This item went before the Board on December 11, 2018, to extend the monthly countywide janitorial services BC17-228 with the Big Green Cleaning Company for an additional twenty-four (24) months. Inadvertently, the total contract amount was not updated correctly so the contract needs to be amended correcting the not to exceed contract amount and resetting the 5% amendment authorization for the Director of General Services.

Background:

On December 11, 2018, the First Amendment to the Big Green Cleaning Company was taken to the Board. The First Amendment extended the contract for an additional twenty-four (24) months and increased the contract amount by \$59,932.00 for a total two year extension in the amount of \$2,756,652.00. The not to exceed amount was in error. The not to exceed amount should be the original contract amount of \$2,696,720.00 plus the extended two year contract amount of \$2,756,652.00, for a total not to exceed of \$5,453,372.00.

In order to continue to pay Big Green for services rendered as this error was corrected, pursuant to authority granted by the Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors on December 11, 2018, the Director of General Services increased the total Contract amount by \$137,833 (Second Amendment).

The Third Amendment (Attachment 1) for contract BC17-228 corrects the not to exceed amount of \$2,756,652.00 to \$5,453,372.00.

It is recommend that if any future amendments are needed for change in scope, the Director of General Services will be authorized to modify within 5% of total contract for BC17-228, in an amount not to exceed \$272,668.60.

Performance Measure:

General Services will continue to closely monitor the vendor's performance to ensure adherence to Section 7 Standard of Performance in the Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor. General Services will be conducting, at a minimum, thirty six (36) onsite inspections to monitor the vendor's responsiveness to requests and ability to keep County facilities at the level of cleanliness expected by the County.
